DRESS CLARIFICATION

Dear Nobles and Daughters,

This is an additional point of clarification to my letter addressing social injustice.

If a member wants to participate in activities protesting social injustice, that is his/her constitutional right. This organization does not take that right away from them.

The A.E.A.O.N.M.S., Inc. cannot tell you what to wear. You can wear whatever you choose to wear as an individual. If you decide to wear your Shrine or Daughters shirt that is your choice; however, you will not be acting on behalf of the organization. You will be acting as an individual. Whatever you decide to do is your individual decision, not a decision of this organization.

We continue to encourage everyone to work with non-violent organizations, who are trained and equipped to address non-violent and violent protests. We will also continue to encourage practicing COVID-19 precautions as you express your constitutional rights. In all of this, you must remember that COVID-19 is still out there, and it is killing our people.

Finally, I encourage you to get out and vote. Voting is our biggest weapon against social injustice. We must continue to work with those organizations, such as the NAACP, whose main goal is to eradicate social injustice.
