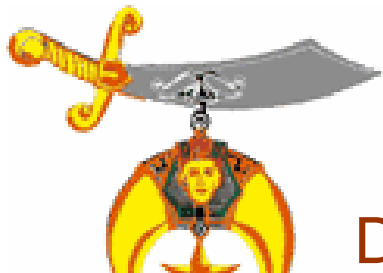

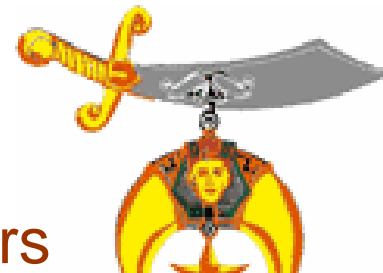
## Objectives
